of adults are either not Insecurity current on their rent or mortgage payment, or have slight or no confidence in making their next payment on time.

**Eviction**/ of adults living in Foreclosure households not



current on rent or mortgage, report that eviction or foreclosure in the next two months is either somewhat likely or very likely.

of adults live in households where it has been somewhat or very difficult to pay for usual household expenses during the pandemic.

#### Change in Education Plans


